Purpose of Role:

This role plays an integral part of the Maintenance team. Carrying out electrical, mechanical and general maintenance of all plant and equipment at Gen 2 Carbon.

Responsibilities

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Maintain all machinery and instrumentation equipment, including but not limited to non-woven carding machine, conveying systems, cutting lines, furnace and dust extraction systems;
- Detect and repair electrical faults on site and modify when required;
- Good understanding of Siemens and/or Allen Bradley PLC's to enable fault finding;
- Be proficient with pneumatics and hydraulics and electrical motors
- To install or be part of the installation team for new equipment and decommission old equipment as and when required;
- Carry out preventative maintenance checks;
- Undertake pre-planned, routine and general maintenance as required on site;
- Participate in on call rota for breakdowns outside of contractual hours as required;
- Complete detailed reports of all work carried out.

Minimum Education Qualifications:

- Hold 18th edition electrical qualification preferred

Minimum Previous Experience:

- Trained and experienced in both mechanical and electrical disciplines;
- Proven knowledge of industrial process equipment;
- Able to work at heights;
- Have at least 5 years proven experience of working in a maintenance role within an industrial/manufacturing environment.

Minimum Additional Training:

- IPAF – boom and scissor license advantageous

Minimum Required Skills:

- Confident self-starter who can work on own initiative but also a team player within a small department;
- Great communicator;
- Good knowledge of health and safety procedures;
- Ability to remain calm under pressure;
